A NOTE FROM YOUR FRIENDLY TREASURER:

This report continues from the last report of February 18, 2022.

The great news is that we have received \$10,600 in membership renewals so far in 2022! The other piece of income for us was the payments by our members for their meals at the Old Elks. After deducting expenses, we have a net income so far this year of a bit over \$9,100!

Since my report to you on February 18th, we have paid for another beach picnic, some name tags for new members, for mailing out the 2022 Member Directory and our usual monthly payments for telephone service. In addition, we paid to rent the Old Elks Club, provide a band and were reimbursed for the meals consumed by our members. We have no debts outstanding.

Our Balance Sheet is in good condition. We have over \$24,000 in our checking and savings accounts. Our investment in Kona Ocean Center has a value of a bit over \$93,000. Thus our total assets as of June 28th are \$117,773.78.
