KITCHEN – *Recipe from Cathy Barrett*

Applesauce

INGREDIENTS:

- 4 medium cooking apples (1 ½ lb), peeled, cut into fourths and cored
- ½ cup water
- ¼ cup packed brown sugar or 3 to 4 tablespoons granulated sugar
- ¼ teaspoon ground cinnamon
- ⅛ teaspoon ground nutmeg

STEPS:

1. In 2-quart saucepan, heat apples and water to boiling over medium heat, stirring occasionally; reduce heat. Simmer uncovered 5 to 10 minutes, stirring occasionally to break up apples, until tender.
2. Stir in remaining ingredients. Heat to boiling. Boil and stir 1 minute. Cover and refrigerate until serving. Store covered in refrigerator.
